

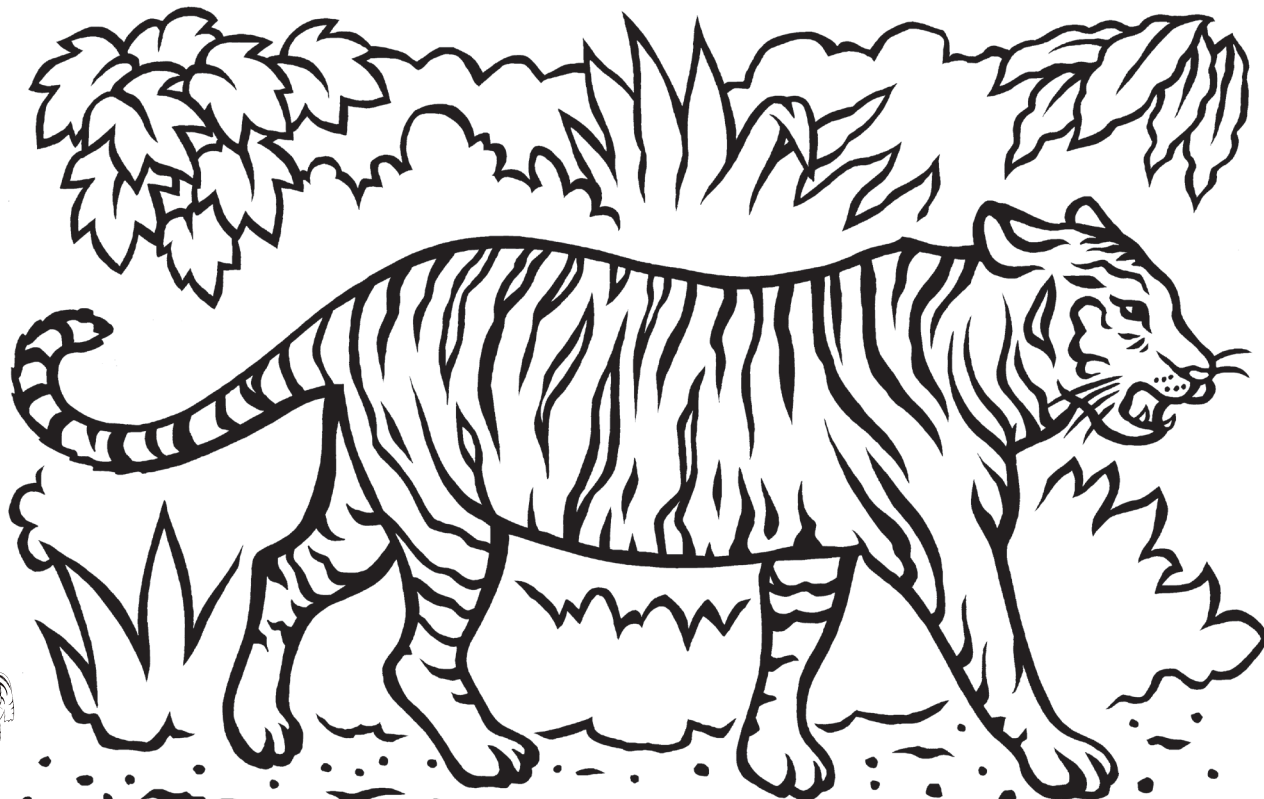


Did you know?

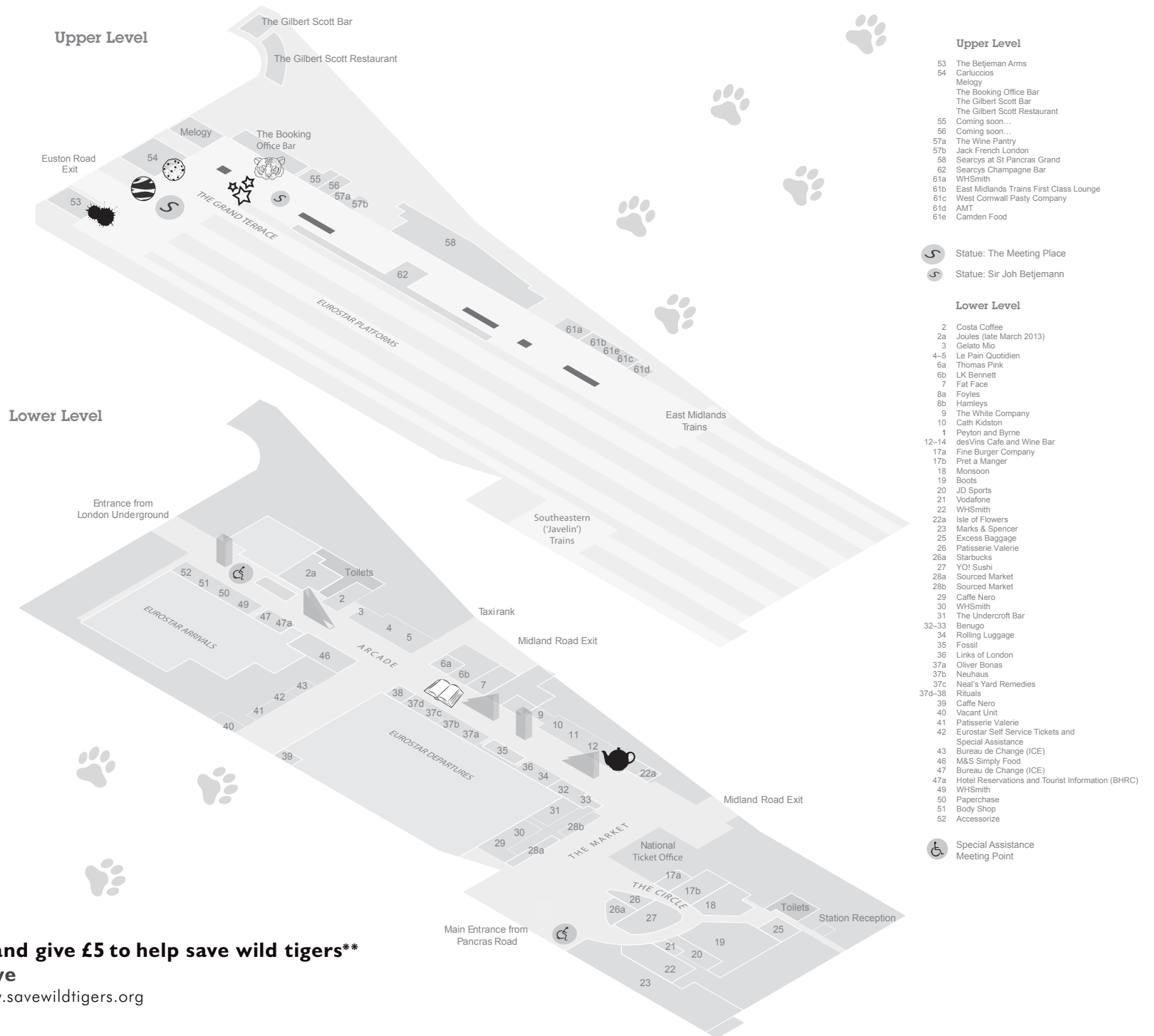
All activities come with a suggested donation of £2 which goes straight to helping Save Wild Tigers.
