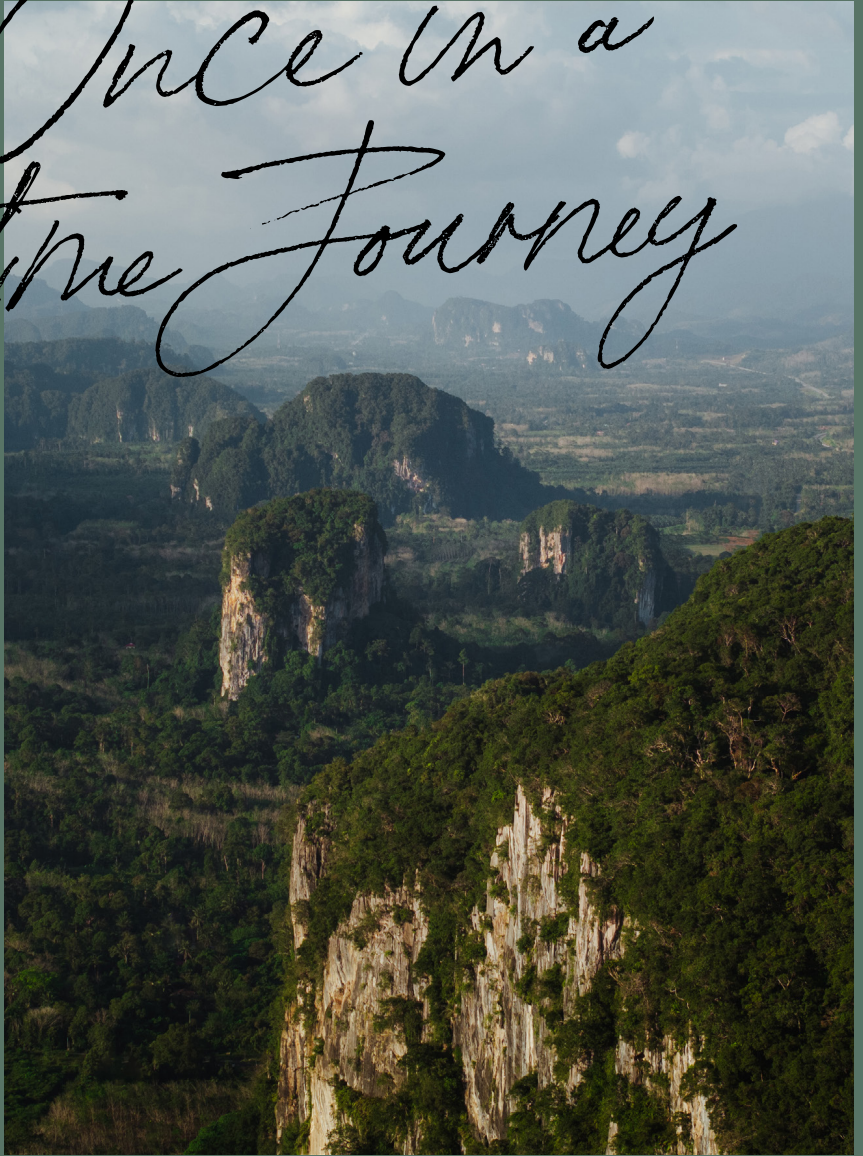

PENANG ISLAND



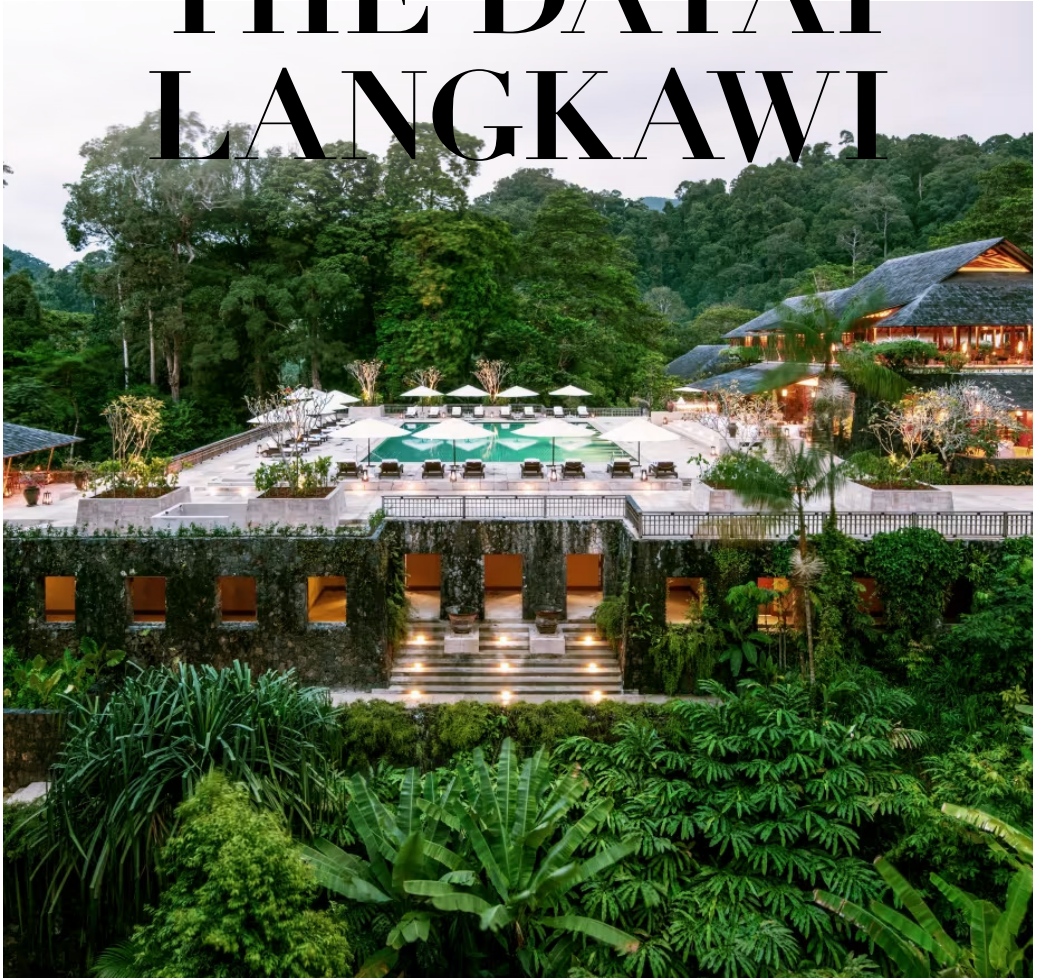
